

The School Day

The current school day

Foundation Stage and Key Stage One	8.40 to 11.40 am (15 min break at 10.00 am) 12.45 to 2.50 pm (15 min break at 1.45 pm on Wed, Thurs, Fri)
Key Stage Two	8.40 to 11.50 am (15 min break at 10.15am) 12.45 to 2.50 pm (no break)

Lunchtime: Pupils may go home, have a school meal or bring a packed lunch. Arrangements are flexible on a daily basis with children being able to select from the menu as to what they would like if they have a school meal. All children in reception, year 1 and year 2 are entitled to a free school meal every day, regardless of circumstances. We have a very able and committed School Meals Team and meals are recommended!

Changing the length of the school day

The government's white paper lays out plans for mainstream state-funded schools to provide a 32.5-hour week, or 6.5 hour days, by September 2023. The governing board is responsible for setting the length of the school day.

The Headteacher has drawn up plans to change the school day and presented these to governors in the summer term 2022. Governors have discussed and scrutinised them. The school welcomed comments from parents/carers.
