

## National Curriculum Tests EYFS and Key Stage 1 Assessment Results 2025

### EYFS

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'good level of development' (at least 'expected' attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths) in 2025 was 65%.

### YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING

In 2025, the percentage of pupils passing the phonics screening check was 95% compared with a national figure of 80%. The results for KS1 phonics are based on a national test set in June.
