We have had a fantastic week, some great achievements from our Stars of the week.

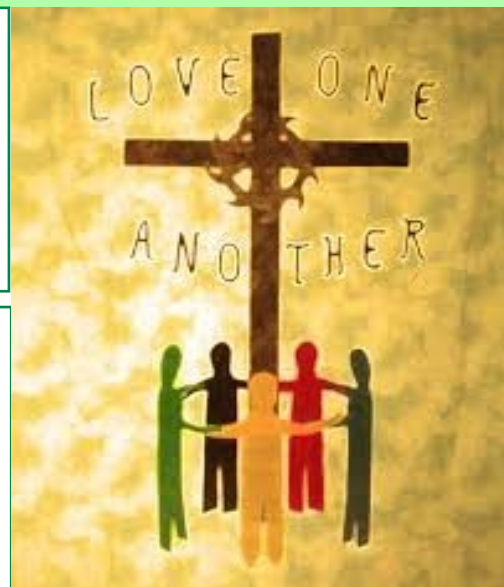
There was some lovely work in the pool from our Year 5 swimmers this week and from the children who took part in the Singfest in Congleton.

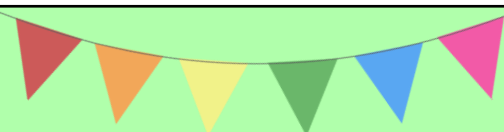
