Termly Pledge

Please can you help support us with termly pledge money from September. Each year every Catholic school is asked to contribute to the Diocesan Build Fund, this fund supports the building projects of all Catholic schools throughout the Diocese of Shrewsbury, as we do not receive full funding for builds and refurbishments from the government. Since 2021 it has supported our school at St Mary's with a new hatch in the foyer, sky lights, replacement gutters, resurfacing of the pathways, new boiler, garage repair, new dishwasher, steamer and CCTV and new gates.

The money you provide is also used to provide extra outstanding provision for our children throughout the year.

School Car Park

The school parking bays are for staff and authorised visitors such as Cheshire East employees.

As you are aware, the school is equipped with 1 disabled parking space. If the school disabled parking space is occupied, the blue badge, which is intended for on-street parking, will allow you to park on single or double yellow line for up to 3 hours.
