

**NATIONAL CURRICULUM TESTS
EYFS AND KEY STAGE 1 ASSESSMENT RESULTS**

EYFS

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'good level of development' (at least 'expected' attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths) in 2023 was 67%.

YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING

In 2023, the percentage of pupils passing the phonics screening check was 85% compared with a national figure of 79%. The results for KS1 phonics are based on a national test set in June.

Children are currently tested at the end of Key Stage 2 in line with statutory requirements. This is in addition to assessment and recording procedures established in line with our whole school policy. In 2024, Key Stage 1 SATs will no longer be compulsory national tests.

AVERAGE SCORE
