



Where Did Vincent Get His Ideas From?


Vincent's brother worked in an art gallery in Paris in France. He wrote to Vincent and told him all about a new style of art called impressionism.





Vincent cut off part of his ear after an argument with another artist.






What Did Vincent Do Next?

Glossary

impressionism: A style of art where the artist tries to capture a moment of life how they see it instead of making it look realistic.



What Are Vincent van Gogh's Most Famous Paintings?

Vincent loved the blue skies, colourful fields and the bright sunshine at his new home and used them in his art. Two of his most famous paintings are called 'Sunflowers' and 'Starry Night'. He painted these when he was living in the south of France. He also painted his bedroom in his yellow house.

What Happened to Vincent van Gogh?

Vincent sometimes felt very angry or sad and could not control these feelings. He used painting as a way to show his feelings and to

help him feel better.

Vincent went into hospital but did not get better. He died on 29th July 1890 in France. He was 37 years old.
