At KS1, results are based on teacher assessment informed by a test. Cheshire East has been highlighted as a local authority who have been harsh in their judgments and therefore advice. As we were a moderated school in Cheshire East (25% of schools were moderated) we feel on reflection we were strict in our judgments, particularly with regards to those children working at greater depth. It is also worth remembering that all schools were using a new assessment framework and inconsistencies in the first year whilst not helpful, are perhaps understandable.

The above information does not alter the fact that the school consistently analyses both internal and external data very carefully and looks to address any weaknesses, in its school development plan.

Again, St. Mary's was one of 25% of school moderated in Cheshire East. Data over recent years shows standards of writing to be high at St. Mary's. We do not believe these results reflect an accurate picture of how St. Mary's compares nationally. As in KS1, this does not alter the fact that analysis of results helps us address any weaknesses in our School Development Plan.
