Abernant Lake Year 6 Residential

The trip takes place on the 26th June to 28th June 2024. The cost of the trip is £295.00 per pupil which is due by 28th April 2024 and payment instalments have been set up on ParentPay. If you would like your child to attend please can you secure your child's place on ParentPay and pay the £20.00 deposit and first instalment of £55.00 by the 28th December 2023.

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to this meal free of charge.


For other Year Groups, the cost of the school Christmas Lunch is £2.50 and payment needs to be made by ParentPay, www.parentpay.com¹
