

## Year 6 Responsibilities

This year, you have the opportunity to take on a Year 6 Responsibility and be a positive role model for the younger children within our school community. The available positions are:

**House Captains** will be responsible for collecting house points from each class and sharing the totals with the rest of the school in Celebration Assembly each Friday. House Captains will also act as Prayer Leaders for our class taking it in turns to lead our prayers each week.

**Class Aides** will be responsible for supporting a class teacher with jobs around the classroom during break and/or lunch times. This may include setting up or collecting resources, sharpening pencils, tidying up classrooms etc. In Year 6, the Class Aides will also check Homework and Reading Records have been completed each week.

**Reading Ambassadors** will be responsible for promoting a love of reading around school. They will look after the Library and Reading Shed, listen to other children read, read stories to younger children and model reading for pleasure around school.

**Well-Being Warriors** will be responsible for promoting the well-being of all children within school. This may include organising games or activities, supporting the Midday Supervisors in looking after children who are hurt or sad and running a Friendship Bench for children who are feeling lonely.

**Environment Officers** will be responsible for ensuring our school is kept clean and tidy. This may include tidying shared areas such as cloakrooms, supporting the Midday Supervisors in tidying up after lunch and checking that lights, computers and whiteboards are not left on when rooms are not in use.

**Sports Leaders** will work closely alongside Coach Gary and Mrs Martin to promote sport within school. They will be responsible for collecting and tidying away equipment, organising sports events such as Sports Day and modelling good sportsmanship to other children.

**Music Monitors** will be responsible for supporting Mrs Hughes with hymns during hymn practise, assembly and Mass, helping Mrs Reed with choir and collecting or returning instruments to the Music cupboard.

Your homework is to write an application letter to Mrs Hughes for your chosen job. Please include:

- Which responsibility you would like to have
- The House you are in (House Captains) or the class you would prefer to support (Class Aides)
- Why you would like to have this responsibility
- Anything you have done at home or in school that would help you with this responsibility
- Any strengths/skills/qualities you have that will help you to perform this responsibility successfully
- Anything else you can think of to make you stand out
- Another responsibility you would enjoy having if you don't get your first choice

Your application letters can be typed or handwritten but need to be handed in to Mrs Hughes by **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September**.
