

NATIONAL CURRICULUM TESTS EYFS AND KEY STAGE 1 ASSESSMENT RESULTS 2024

EYFS

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'good level of development' (at least 'expected' attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths) in 2024 was 67%.

YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING

In 2024, the percentage of pupils passing the phonics screening check was 91% compared with a national figure of 80%. The results for KS1 phonics are based on a national test set in June.
