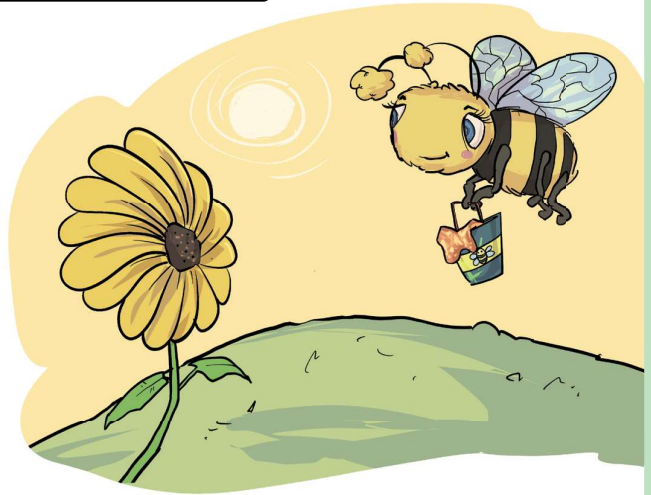


How do bees make honey?

Bees find a flower to drink nectar from with their long tongue. Then the nectar goes into a special stomach where it is turned into sugar.

Inside the hive, the bee spits the sugar into one of the cells on the honeycomb.

The heat in the hive dries up any water from the nectar and then the bees cover the cell over with a cap made from wax.

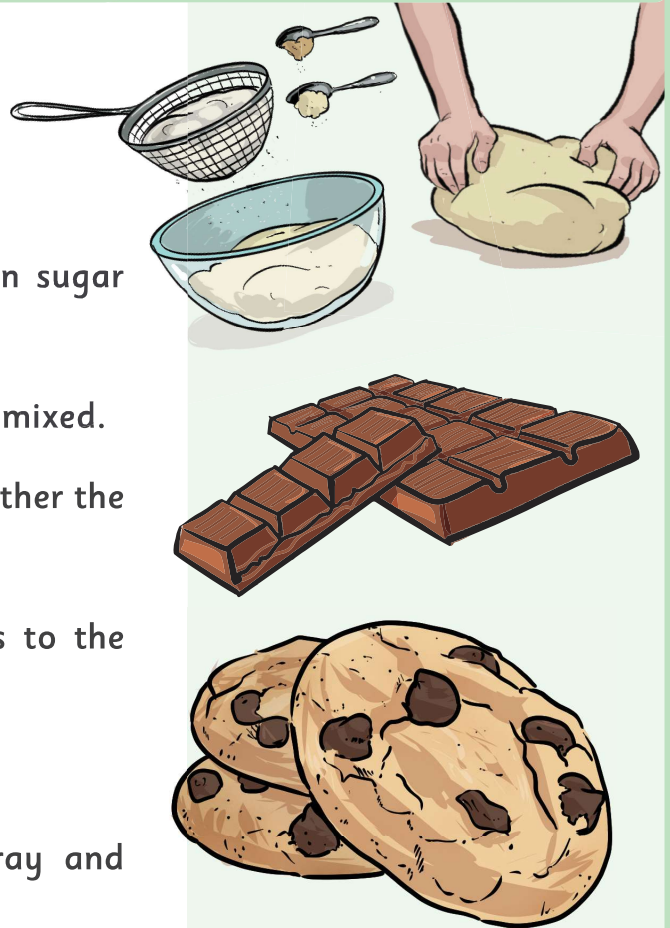

Chocolate chip cookies

Method:

1. Preheat the oven to 190°C.
2. Mix together the butter and brown sugar until light and fluffy.
3. Add in the egg and beat until well mixed.
4. In another mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, and salt.
5. Gradually add the dry ingredients to the egg mixture.
6. Stir in the chocolate chips.
7. Make small balls on a baking tray and cook for 10 minutes.

Dear Diary,

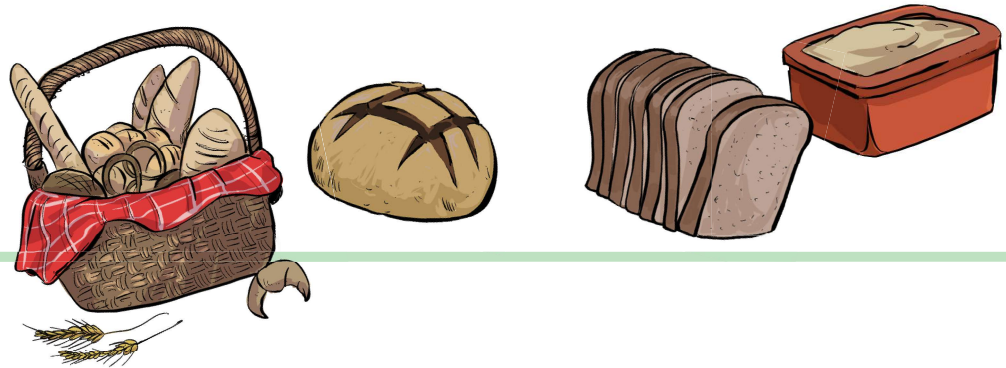
I woke up early to collect the wheat from the field. I asked my friends to help, but they wouldn't. So, I collected it myself.
