#### **Jubilee Workshop**



We have a full day cross curricular workshop focusing on the 2025 Catholic Jubilee on 10th April. The children will explore the Jubilee's theme "Pilgrims of hope" discussing what a pilgrimage is and the characteristics of a pilgrim.

In smaller group sessions, children will be introduced to Luce – the Vatican mascot of the jubilee and her friends. The symbolism of Luce will be explained and there will be the chance to learn some basic Italian such as greetings, saying your name and where you come from. Each child will then produce a small jubilee token to bring home linked to Luce or the jubilee logo.




