If you have any family or friends with a child due to start school in September 2025/2026, please encourage them to come along!



Year 5 pupils were invited to attend an activity day at St Nicholas Catholic High School on Tuesday 18th June. They thoroughly enjoyed themselves.












### **Year 5 Visit to Jodrell Bank**
