Message from the PTA - Summer Fair

The School Summer Fair was held on Friday 4th July and was once again a roaring success. Making these events successful relies on a huge commitment from across the whole school community, and the PTA would like to thank all those who volunteered their time and effort to organise activities, plan and run stalls, source and donate raffle prizes etc. etc., and, most importantly, to all of you who came and enjoyed the Fayre and made it an event to remember for the children. The Summer Fair is such a great event because the children in particular get such enjoyment from it and it also helps us raise funds for the PTA charity which ultimately goes to support and enhance the children's school experience. This years Summer Fair raised just over £1,000 after all costs were taken into account which reflects a great effort from everyone.

Fundraising Events have been held through the year, including the Nativity shows, School Discos and the Summer Fair. Throughout the year these events have been very well supported, allowing just under £2,600 of net income to be raised for the PTA charity for the year. We can't thank you enough for all the support you continue to give to help these events be successful.

Over the course of the year, the PTA has provided £2,690 of funding to the school which was mostly front loaded to allow the funds to be spent on specific items to support the pupils of the school, including providing a £200 per class budget to enhance learning, and supporting the installation of equipment for the newly established Nursery provision.

On behalf of the PTA, we hope you enjoy a restful and relaxing summer break.


