# **Summer Reading Challenge**

The summer holidays are nearly here and it's important that our pupils don't lose the momentum they've built for their reading habits whilst they're out of school. A great way to keep encouraging their love of reading is to get involved with the Cheshire public libraries summer reading challenges.

Children age 0-12 can take part in the Summer Reading Challenge by signing up in any local library. They will be given a challenge pack and collect stickers along the way. If they complete the challenge (to read six books in any format), they will be rewarded with a medal and a certificate.

### Staying healthy on your summer holiday

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) have drafted a letter for parents and carers before children break up for the summer holidays which has been sent by ParentPay.

The letter reminds families who are planning to travel abroad for holidays or to visit relatives, to check if they need any vaccinations before they go, in particular, MMR, Hep A and Typhoid, and includes general advice on how to keep safe and well.

This is particularly important with the current rise in measles cases in the Cheshire and Merseyside region.

### **HAF Provision St Mary's**

This holiday provision is for school aged children from reception to year 11 (inclusive) who receive benefits-related free school meals.

Benefits-related free school meals (FSM) are available to pupils if their parents are in receipt of one of the qualifying benefits, and have a claim verified by their school or local authority.

Further information on eligibility for free school meals is available<sup>1</sup>.

Local authorities are asked to ensure that the offer of free holiday club provision is available for all children in receipt of benefits-related free school meals in their area, though this does not mean we expect all to attend as the provision is voluntary.

We also encourage local authorities to make the holiday clubs available to any children not receiving free school meals who can pay to attend. This might be through operating:

- bespoke provision
- as part of already existing holiday provision in the area
- a mixed arrangement depending on the local supply and demand for provision
