A day in Reception.

Our school day begins at 8.30 am.

The children arrive – hang up their bags and coats, choose their dinner choice and sit down with a book.

The bell goes at 8.40 and we take the register.

We begin the day with a class worship and prayer.

There will be an input for English or Maths followed by adult led group activities and self choosing activities in our indoor and outdoor classroom.

At 10.15 am we have a play time and fruit snack.

At 10.30 am we have our second input either English or Maths followed by activities just like the first input.

At 11.15 am we have phonic when we learn new letter sounds and words.

Lunch is 11.40 – 12.45 We have a lunch time prayer before we go to the hall.

At 12.45 we take the afternoon register and do the ANGELUS (our Hail Mary)

In the afternoon we cover the other areas such as 'understanding the world, Religious Education, French, Expressive art and design.

We have a playtime 13.45 – 14.00

The last session is Story time then home time is 14.50

Some days we have Physical Education sessions (PE) and assemblies in the hall.

Our International school links

In Year 3 we are lucky enough to be in touch with a school in Brazil - Colégio Santa Úrsula.

We have been learning about Santa Úrsula through emails from the children in third grade and also from their teacher, Mrs. Izippato.

St. Ursula school is a Brazilian catholic of 2,000 students, from nursery (babies aged 4 months) to high school (teenagers aged 18). They follow the Maria Montessori's methodology of learning and encourage learners to learn at their own pace and we respect their individuality.

Their Ursuline mission in the world is supported by the legacy of Angela Merici, in the light of the Gospel. They develop their educational practices aiming at the holistic formation of their pupils, at the service of life.

The Ursuline mission links in closely to our own at St Mary's where we also have God at the heart of everything we do.

The children in Year 3 have loved finding out about their partnership friends (predominantly what they like to eat and their favorite hobbies) and we can wait for this bond to blossom even more!

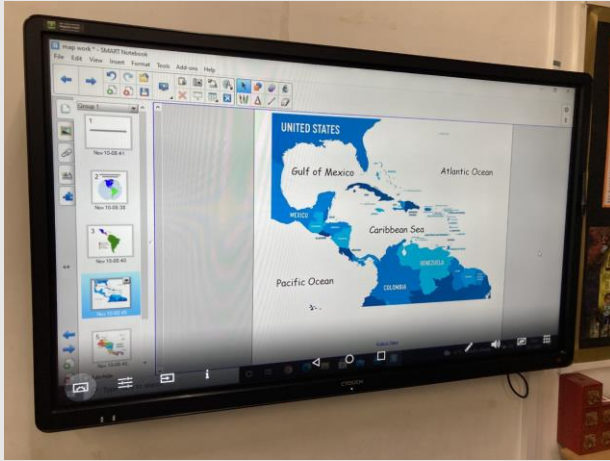
Scuola Primaria Caterina Cittadini in Bergamo

We have a bank of iPads and Chromebooks that children can use in classrooms for research and educational games.



We are really lucky to have an ICT suite with enough computers for each child in the class where we go for our Computing lessons.

Each classroom has an Interactive Whiteboard to support teaching and learning across the curriculum. There is a special pen that lets you write directly onto the screen.



During our Computing lessons, we use a programme called Purple Mash. We learn how to code and create computer games as well as using word processors, spreadsheets, databases and emails. We also learn how to stay safe online.

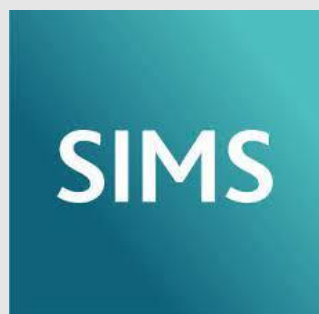




Our school website provides lots of information for children, parents and visitors to the school. Each class has its own class page where teachers can share important information.
